Cheshire Show 2015 RULES AND ADVICE TO EXHIBITORS

We are again publishing CFWI's rules and useful advice for our competitions at the Cheshire Show as a separate sheet, to make it easier for WIs to copy and circulate these details to all exhibitors, who are strongly advised to read carefully both General and Section rules, and to consult the 2012 edition of 'On With the Show' when planning and preparing their exhibits.

This information is also included in the Schedule as usual

GENERAL RULES

- Individual members may enter classes 1,2,3,4,5,and 6.
 ONE entry per individual member per class.
- 2. Wis may enter classes 7,8,9, and 10. ONE entry per WI per class.
- 3. In classes 7 10, the exhibit to be the work of at least THREE members.
- 4. Names of individual members or of WIs should not be visible.
- 5. All items to be judged must be labelled with the exhibitor's number.
- 6. Wis will be responsible for their own staging. Provided tables will be covered.
- All exhibits to be the bona fide work of the respective WI or individual member.
 Non-members may help ONLY with transporting staging.
- Staging must be complete and ready for assembly on site by WI members only. Painting on site is not allowed.
- All entries, except floral art, will be removed from the staging for judging. Entries in class 4 may be moved, after judging, for display.
- 10. Receipt and staging of entries:

Monday 22 June:

- 9.30am: Staging may begin in classes 7 10; individual entries will be received.
- 11.30am: All exhibitors must leave the marquee: judging begins.
- 11.Members may work only in their allotted spaces.
- 12.No exhibit is to be removed from the display before 5.30pm on Wednesday 24 June, but members are urged to collect all entries between 5.30 and 6pm. The Committee will not be responsible for anything remaining after this time.
- 13.Whilst every care will be taken, neither the Cheshire Federation of Women's Institutes nor the Cheshire Agricultural Society can be held responsible for any article lost or damaged in the WI marquee.
- All exhibits will be judged in accordance with the guidelines in the NFWI handbook 'On With the Show',
 2012 edition.
- 15. The judges' decisions are final in competitive classes.
- 16.WIs or individual members who are unable to exhibit in any class they have entered should inform one of the Exhibition Secretaries BEFORE 6pm on Friday 19 June 2015. Please contact:
