

## PRODUCE RULES

1. No entries will be accepted which have been previously shown or exhibited.
2. All jars and bottles must be of clear untinted glass. Any container bearing a trade name or trade markings will be disqualified. Bar codes and 'sell by' dates must be removed from all jars and bottles. All jars **MUST** have new lids. Cellophane + wax disc may be used if appropriate – see OWTS.
3. Items of preservation must be labelled with day, month and year.
4. Chocolate work and marzipan permissible.
5. No miniatures allowed.
6. Items for judging must be presented whole; individual cut portions (e.g. a slice from a tray bake, cake or pie) **NOT** accepted unless specified in the schedule.
7. **Paté** and **fish** **NOT** acceptable. **Please also read OWTS p.18**, and consider the atmospheric conditions in the marquee when choosing items for showing.
8. If labelling in a foreign language or using a creative title, please add a clear English sub-title. For unusual items, please provide the recipe, written on a small card, on judging day. This will not be displayed on show days.
9. Wine kits are not permissible. Wine must be presented in clear glass punted bottles with new flanged corks which need not be sealed.
10. Exhibitors may choose to cover food items before judging (OWTS 2012 pp.18 and 123 refer), and decorated or novelty cakes may be covered throughout the show.
11. For safety reasons, please **DO NOT** use any sharp or hazardous materials, e.g. metals, wood, plastics, glitter, on/in food exhibits, as your entry may be judged 'Not Acceptable'.

## CRAFT RULES

1. Articles must not have been shown previously at the Cheshire Show.
2. Items must be finished, made up and easily **REMOVED** from staging for judging. Please state if framing has been done by a WI member.
3. Please state on mark card whether design is original, adapted or a kit. **In class 5 this is mandatory.**
4. Please state if any quilted item has been made up on a long-arm machine, **and note general rule 7.**
5. Jewellery must be completely hand-made, except for fastenings.
6. Art and photography are **NOT** classified as crafts, but art and photography are permissible in Classes 7 and 10 as the additional item(s).

NB: Please indicate on entry forms any unusual crafts you intend to include, so that appropriate judges may be invited.

## FLORAL ART AND DESIGN RULES

Please observe these rules, or your entry may be marked 'Not according to schedule'.

1. Exhibits must comply with the schedule in content and size.
2. The use of artificial plant material is **not** allowed in floral arrangements which are to be judged.
3. The cut ends of fresh plant material must be in water or water-retaining material (except for strong fibrous stems which do not have to be in water but must remain *turgid* for the duration of the show).
