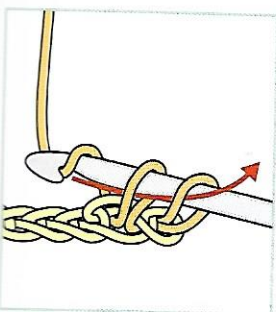
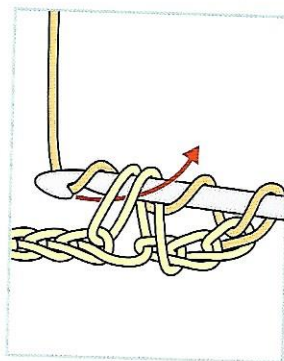


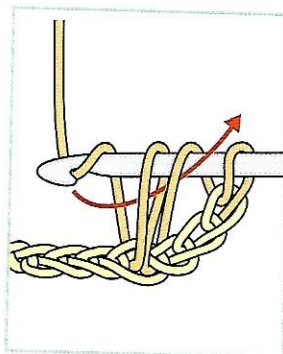
1 When working into a chain, miss one chain (unless instructed otherwise), insert the hook in the next chain, yarn round hook, pull the yarn through the chain to make two loops on the hook.



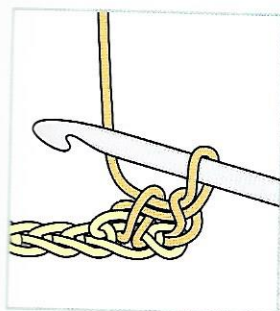
2 Yarn round hook and pull the yarn through both loops on the hook.



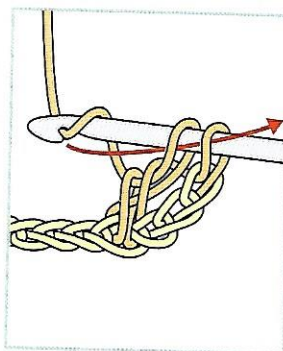
2 Yarn round hook and pull the yarn through the chain to make three loops on the hook.



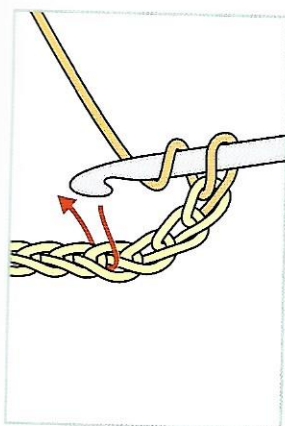
3 Yarn round hook and pull the yarn through the first two loops on the hook.



This completes a double crochet, which is the second stitch of the row, the first being the missed chain.



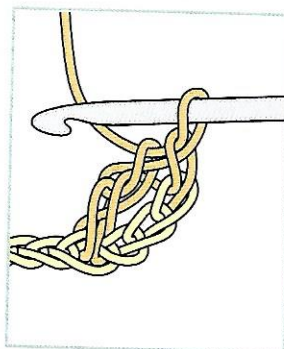
4 Yarn round hook and pull the yarn through the remaining two loops on the hook.



11 Treble

This is a taller stitch which is even more versatile for patterning than double crochet.

1 When working into a chain, yarn round hook, miss three chain, insert the hook in the next chain.



This completes a treble, which is the second stitch of the row, the first being the three missed chain.
