The town motto for Northwich is "Sal Est Vita", which is Latin for "Salt is Life". This motto reflects the town's long and significant history as a salt and brine-producing center, a tradition that dates back to Roman times. Come with the Public Affairs team and visit the Lion Salt Works in Northwich to explore the site and its restored buildings. Here we will discover how the salt works operated and the impact of salt on mid-Cheshire's people, economy, and landscape.

We will meet at 10:30 and have a guided tour of the works followed by a buffet lunch at 1pm.
